Please read your boat ramp agreement carefully before signing it. It is a privilege to use the ramp and it is your responsibility to abide by the rules and regulations. The Ramp Committee will be monitoring the ramp daily for violations, and we ask that you show consideration for others when using the boat ramp this summer.

To allow access to Cornfield Road residences, only one vehicle with a boat trailer at a time is permitted to wait on Cornfield Road to use the ramp. Overflow parking for trailers with stickers is on median strip of Magothy Road and across Grandview on Twin Beach Road. **All others will be towed.**

## **Welcome Summer!**


