Mosquito Spraying

Community Mosquito Liaison:

Hello to all our Long Point community residents. The following is to inform & update you regarding our 2015-2016 mosquito control spraying for our county/community.



Our designated night for mosquito control spraying will be Wednesday evenings from 7:00 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. It should begin around the 2nd Wednesday in June.

The following is taken directly from the MDA Mosquito Control directives: "The community agrees to allow access by MDA personnel to conduct mosquito services. The community agrees to assist mosquito control efforts by promoting good land use planning & community clean-ups to reduce areas of stagnant water that provide habitat for larval mosquitoes." Remember it only takes a drop of standing water to hatch those pesky mosquito larvae! Any resident that wishes to have his/her property

excluded from adult mosquito control service must notify the Maryland Department of Agriculture and myself by submitting a completed exemption form. The Department policy on objection to adult mosquito control services and the exemption form are available on the website at:

- To avoid tire ruts at the ramp which make the grass hard to cut, please do not park on the grass when the ground is soft after heavy rains.
- LPIA parking areas on Magothy Road and Twin Beach Road are to be used **only as overflow parking** for boat ramp trailers/vehicles, and **not** for trailer storage. Thank you.

Unauthorized vehicles, including cars, trucks, and motorized and non-motorized vehicles, whether licensed or unlicensed, are **NOT** permitted or allowed to park, and/or drive onto or across Community Property without prior approval from the Association.






Gift from the Sea by Anne Morrow Lindbergh
