MOSQUITO SPRAYING

As in the past, our community will be included in the County's Mosquito Control Program.



For 2017, our assigned spray night is Thursday.

- Our community will only be sprayed on Thursday nights during the 2017 season.
- Spraying can occur anytime between 7:00 PM and 2:30 AM.
- Regular service should commence on May 31st and is estimated to end on Oct. 3rd.
- Residents who do not wish their property to be sprayed may file an exemption. The exemption policy and form can be found on our website: <http://mda.maryland.gov/plants-pests/Documents/MosquitoControlExemptionForm.pdf>.

On our assigned spray night the county coordinators suggest the following precautions

- Stay indoors
- Shut windows
- Turn off window air conditioning units
- Bring in pet dishes, children's toys, etc.

When: Boat Ramp keys are distributed in April, May and June each year, usually on the 2nd Tuesday of that month. The last session will be **Tuesday, June 13th from 6-7 PM.**

If you cannot attend, please contact either Rick (410-255-7374) or Pat (410-255-9623) to arrange for an alternate time. Rick and Pat of course would greatly appreciate your efforts to attend the June 13th meeting if at all possible - it makes things much simpler.

What to bring: In addition to your LPIA membership and boat ramp dues, you must provide original boat, trailer, and vehicle information at the time of registration. **ADDITIONALLY, WE ARE NOT ISSUING NEW KEYS!** Last year's key will be used, but you must register!

Boat Ramp Parking

IMPORTANT!! A 2017 sticker must be visible on your boat trailer or it will be towed!!

To avoid tire ruts at the ramp which make the grass hard to cut, please do not park on the grass when the ground is soft after heavy rains.

LPIA parking areas on Magothy Road and Twin Beach Road are to be used **only as overflow parking** for boat ramp trailers/vehicles, and **not** for trailer storage. Thank you.



Community Beaches and Property

Reminder

For all our beach users, please remember that the beaches and community properties are for all our residents to enjoy, but they are for people, **not** vehicles.

You are allowed to carry your kayak or canoe across community property to launch from a beach, but please use the community boat ramp to launch trailered boats and personal watercraft.

Please do not park on roadways with signage that says 'No Parking'! Examples of this are Long Point Road and Gibson Rd. Long Point has a bike lane and Gibson Rd. is narrow and large vehicles can't fit down there. Cars will be towed.

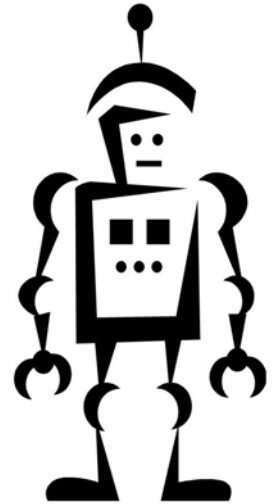
